
THE 44th INTERNATIONAL OCTOBER CONFERENCE ON MINING AND METALLURGY

The 44th International October Conference on Mining and Metallurgy organized annually, aims at providing a forum for presentation and discussion of scientific research, technological development and practice on the subjects of geology, mining, metallurgy, material science, technology, environmental protection, energy efficiency and related engineering topics.

The Conference has been organized jointly by Mining and Metallurgy Institute Bor and Technical Faculty in Bor, University of Belgrade. Firstly, it was a national conference, then a conference with international participation and since 2002 - international conference.

TIME AND VENUE

The 44th IOC will be held in October 1-3 2012 at Hotel "Albo", Bor (Serbia), a main industrial town in Eastern Serbia (about 250 km south-east of Belgrade).

TOPICS

The topics of the 44th IOC are:

geology, underground mining, surface mining, mineral processing, extractive metallurgy, metal processing, materials science, inorganic technology, environmental engineering, industrial engineering, recycling technologies, energetics, manufacturing technologies, quality management, software engineering applications, mechatronics, machining, design and construction, and other related fields.

PROGRAM

The Conference will be organized in sections, including plenary lecture, section lectures, oral and poster presentations.

PUBLISHING

The Conference Proceedings will be published including only the papers accepted by the Scientific Committee. The papers should be written in English, max. 4 pages, typed by Microsoft Word (versions 98 and higher), font – Times New Roman 12 pt, A4 paper format (all margins 2.5 cm), single spaced, tables – Microsoft Word format, figures – .gif, .tif, .jpg format. The papers should be organized into following sections: Abstract (100 - 200 words), Keywords, Introduction, Experimental, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, Acknowledgement and References. The title of the paper together with names of authors and their addresses should be given at the

beginning of the text. The papers should be sent in electronic form, i.e. CD or e-mail.

The authors can prepare their papers in extended form and submit them as full-length research papers in *Journal of Mining and Metallurgy*, Section A: Mining and Section B: Metallurgy (the instructions for the preparation of papers are given at JMM site - www.jmmab.com), as well as in the national journals *Rudarski radovi* and *Bakar* (the instructions for the preparation of papers are given at site - www.irmbor.co.rs/index.php/izdavastvo), after reviewing and appropriate revisions.

CONFERENCE LANGUAGE

The Conference language will be English.

CONFERENCE FEE

The Conference fee is € 100 - Net Amount. It includes admission to the Conference sessions, Conference Proceedings and the accompanying materials, welcome cocktail, conference dinner, and refreshments during the Conference.

The conference fee for the accompanying person is € 50. It includes all items specified for the participants except the Conference Proceedings and the accompanying materials.

The conference fee for the publishing the accepted papers is € 40.
